Real-Time Cognitive Evaluation of Online Learners through Automatically Generated Questions

The approach automatically extracts text from video lectures to generate the when learners respond with an answer, the proposed approach further evaluates the response and provides feedback. Besides enhancing learner's engagement, this approach's main benefits are that it frees instructors from designing questions to check the comprehension of a topic. Thus, instructors can spend this time productively on other activities.

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There has been a shift in recent times from traditional classroom learning towards remote learning. This implies that students can enrol in coarses from different universities without needing to be physically present on the universities camputes. Open online video coarse portals tike MIT OpenCoarseWare, Coarsera, edX and others have gained much popularity because of their high-quality video lectures, which a student can access at any time and from anywhere. To ensure that students have grasped the concepts explained in a video lecture, there is a need to assess students on various topics presented in a video lecture. Traditionally, a coarse instructor manually prepares a set of questions to evaluate the broad understanding of the material that has been taught. However, manually preparing questions is a time-consuming and cumbersome task. An instructor could use the time spent designing questions to prepare lecture material and presentations, which will be more fruitful and heneficial for the students and the coarse instructor himself.

The question designing task can be automated with advanced techniques from Natural Language Processing and Video Processing Automatic question generation is the task.







This Memorandum of Understanding ('MOU') is executed this _____ day of December, 2021

ASTEC LIFESCIENCES LIMITED [Corporate Identity Number (CIN): L99999MH1994PLC076236], a Company incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956, having its Registered Office situated at "Godrej One", 3rd Floor, Pirojshanagar, Eastern Express Highway, Vikhroli (East), Mumbai – 400 079, Maharashtra, India and factories situated at Mahad, District Raigad, Maharashtra, India (hereinafter referred to as "ASTEC", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its successors in business and permitted assigns) of the FIRST PART

AND

DR. BABASAHEB AMBEDKAR TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY, LONERE, DISTRICT RAIGAD, an educational University specialized in Imparting technical education situated at Lonere, District Raigad, Maharashtra, India (hereinafter referred to as "The University", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its successors in business and permitted assigns) of the OTHER PART.

ASTEC and The University are hereinafter individually referred to as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

WHEREAS:

- ASTEC approached The University with a proposal of imparting Training at Mahad to their employees (which may include employees of holding, subsidiary or associate companies of ASTEC, as may be nominated and decided by ASTEC for the training). The objective is to enhance the technical competency level of the aforesaid employees working in ASTEC by imparting theoretical knowledge in subjects of Chemical Engineering such as Unit Operations, Heat Transfer Operations etc. as may be deemed necessary by ASTEC.
- 2. The University responded positively to the proposal of ASTEC. The University has already engaged itself in such type of training/educational activities for the benefit of employees in other industries. One of the objectives of The University is to extend their services to the industries and the society in general for promoting knowledge up-gradation and technical competency.
- 3. Subsequently, there were series of meetings held between ASTEC and The University. The curriculum, the probable schedules and methodology of training was discussed at length. A Scheme of Training suitable and relevant to the targeted group of participants is framed. The details of the Training Scheme, the roles and responsibilities and the terms and conditions are as enumerated in the following understanding.

NOW THIS MOU WITNESSETH AND IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

SCOPE OF AGREEMENT:

- The University will impart training to the employees as selected by ASTEC in the subjects of Chemical Engineering which are mutually agreed by both the signatories of this MOU through its qualified, expert and experienced faculty and they will assess the performance of individual participants by conducting periodic assessment tests and final examination.
- 2. At the end of program, participants will be issued certificates on behalf of The University and ASTEC referring to their grades achieved.
- 3. ASTEC will provide classroom training facilities at their site at Mahad.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- This MOU shall come into force from the date of its execution and shall be valid for a period of 11 months, which may be extended for such further period(s) as may be decided by mutual consent of both ASTEC and The University in writing.
- 2. The entire training program will be conducted at ASTEC, Mahad premises.

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 The total curriculum designed by The University and agreed by ASTEC is as annexed herewith (Annexure - 1)

4. The University will charge @ Rs. 6,000/- (Rupees Six Thousand Only) per hour for the training.

- The total training hours are estimated at about 144 (One Hundred Forty Four) hours (approximately) for a batch.
- Thus the actual training cost works out to be Rs. 8,64,000/- (Rupses Eight Lakh Sixty Four Thousand Only) for a batch plus GST, as applicable.
- 7. S0% (Fifty per cent) of this amount is to be paid in advance at the time of signing of this MOU. The remaining 50% (fifty per cent) is to be paid in half way towards the completion of program for the participants of ASTEC.
- 8. All taxes and duties, as may be payable from time to time, if any, levied at the time towards such services provided to ASTEC shall be borne by ASTEC to The University as an extra charge. The University should intimate ASTEC in advance if there is any change in taxes and duties before delivery of the training services and ASTEC will not be liable to pay any differential taxes and duties to The University post-delivery of the training services.
 - a) The training cost charged by The University shall be subject to deduction of TDS at applicable rate as per the Income Tax Act, 1961 and after adjustments of dues / claims, if any, except Goods & Service Tax (if applicable) as provided herein.
 - b) In case of any Goods & Service Tax is levied in terms of this Agreement, ASTEC shall pay the Goods & Service Tax on the consideration payable to The University, provided The University seeks registration under Goods & Service Tax Act, 2017 and Goods & Service Tax Rules and submits a copy of such Registration Certificate to ASTEC.
 - c) The University undertakes to remit applicable Goods & Service Tax ('GST') to the appropriate tax jurisdiction of the applicable taxing authority within the time specified in the applicable law. The University undertakes to submit all necessary information, documents and other evidences, including in particular, copy of certificate of registration with tax authorities, copy of challan evidencing payment of GST by The University, and such other documents that may be required by ASTEC to enable ASTEC to claim the credit of GST charged to it by The University. The University should also ensure to make payment of GST against the ASTEC locational GST TIN Number of the jurisdiction as provided to it by ASTEC.
 - d) In the event The University does not remit the GST as stated above, or remits the same to a jurisdiction not as per the GSTIN Number as provided by ASTEC, or claims that it has made the remittance, but the same is not reflected in the GSTIN network of ASTEC, then The University shall become liable to promptly, without delay or demur, reimburse to ASTEC (i) all the GST payable for the training services, and/or (ii) the disallowed or unavailable credits which otherwise ASTEC would be entitled under the applicable law if the GST was properly remitted and supply made by them was disclosed as outward supply in their return The University on its invoices issued to the ASTEC within the time period stated above (iii) the interest and penalties associated with such disallowed or unavailable credits and (iv) all other additional taxes or late charges that may be demanded by or may become payable to the taxing authority from The University.
 - e) The University acknowledges and agrees that in the event any tax proceedings are initiated against ASTEC, The University shall fully co-operate with ASTEC by furnishing the relevant


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information related to the service provided to ASTEC on timely basis as may be required by ASTEC from The University.

- f) The University acknowledges and agrees that it would adhere to the applicable GST compliances which may be monitored by the taxing authorities and any defaults may result in blacklisting or special scrutiny of either of the Parties. Accordingly, in the event of continuing defaults from The University, which results in any kind of adverse actions against ASTEC including special scrutiny of the books of accounts of ASTEC, then ASTEC shall have the right to immediately terminate this Agreement for violation of law committed by THE UNIVERSITY and the breach of this Agreement.
- 9. The traveling arrangements shall be made by ASTEC for the faculty members to and fro from Lonere to ASTEC, Mahad and expenses thereof shall be borne by ASTEC in addition to training cost, subject to production of necessary original supporting documents. ASTEC will also provide local hospitality to the faculty of The University.
- 10. The total number of participants will be around 25 (twenty-five) in the proposed batch. The number of batches shall be determined by ASTEC, depending upon its training requirements. Additional batch, if any, shall be decided mutually by ASTEC and The University,
- 11. ASTEC shall be responsible to provide training facilities at their site along with necessary supports such as stationery, refreshments, lunch & snacks etc.
- The University shall be responsible for providing training. The University will provide the necessary lecture notes and study material and ASTEC will make the required number of copies and distribute it to the participants.
- 13. The University shall also encourage and endeavor to provide electronic or digital learning tools, over and above the classroom learning and study material.
- 14. The University will also be responsible for doing Periodic Assessment preferably after every module to track and monitor the performance of individual participants. Project work to groups, individual assignments relevant to their subjects also will be given to the participants and assessed by The University and also feedback on the same will be given to the participants in a timely manner.
- 15. At the end of this course, The University shall conduct the final test/examination and will give the final assessment of the individuals.
- 16. The University and ASTEC will issue the Certificate of Participation and successful completion of this training along with the grades achieved.
- 17. The training will be conducted on every Saturday for the duration of 4 (four) hours. If any adjustment is needed on either side, this will be done by mutual agreement of both ASTEC and The University for that particular week. These 4 (four) hours will comprise of 2 (two) sessions of 2 (two) hours each, preferably covering two separate subjects. This is to help the participants to keep themselves refresh and interested in continuous learning. In exceptional circumstances, one faculty may engage four hrs. with an appropriate gap in between.
- 18. The language of communication will be English. Wherever necessary, faculty members may use any suitable language to facilitate the participants to understand the subject matter.
- 19. The University shall communicate immediately to the management of ASTEC if they find any of the participants not responding, not able to understand or found not interested in learning. However,



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continuation or discontinuation of such participants in the program shall be at the sole discretion of ASTEC.

- 20. Vacations during Diwall or any other such festival will be decided at that time mutually.
- 21. Any change in the schedule, timing or the contents of this curriculum will be communicated in advance by either party.
- 22. It is compulsory for each participant to attend every session. Cases of any indiscipline or not attending the class by participants will be highlighted by The University faculties to ASTEC management.
- 23. The University and its faculties shall hold any confidential information of ASTEC about its products, operations, and processes, which may come to their knowledge in the course of training, in strict confidence, also after termination of this agreement, and shall not divulge the same to any other person, under any circumstances.


MISCELLANEOUS TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- None of the provisions of this MOU shall be deemed to constitute a partnership between The University and ASTEC.
- 2. The failure, with or without intent, of any Party hereto to insist upon the performance by the other Party, of any term or stipulation of this MOU, shall not be treated as, or be deemed to constitute, a modification of any terms or stipulations of this MOU. Nor shall such failure or election be deemed to constitute a waiver of the right of such Party, at any time whatsoever thereafter, to insist upon performance by the other, strictly in accordance with any terms or provisions hereof.
- 3. Neither Party shall assign this MOU or any of the rights, duties or obligations hereunder without the prior written consent of the other Party. However, ASTEC may assign any/all of the rights, duties or obligations under this MOU to its affiliates and associates provided that intimation of such assignment is provided by ASTEC to The University in writing.
- 4. This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. In case of any dispute between The University and ASTEC, they shall endeavour to resolve the disputes amicably within 30 (Thirty) days from which it arose, by negotiations. In case, the disputes remain unresolved for 30 (thirty) days, it shall be referred to a sole Arbitrator mutually appointed by the Parties. The arbitration proceedings shall be governed by the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The language of Arbitration shall be English and venue shall be Mumbai. Any dispute arising out of or in relation to this Agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts at Mumbai, India.
- 5. Any notice or request required to be permitted to be given or made under this Agreement to the Parties shall be given in writing. Such notice or request shall be deemed to have been duly given or made when it shall be delivered by hand, mail or telegram to the Party to which it shall be delivered as per the address given below:


